

DASH FOR CASH OKOTOKS BMX CLUB PROVINCIAL

Dash for Cash is for the **ELITE MALE 20" CLASS ONLY** for both Saturday and Sunday.

Dash for Cash money **WILL NOT** be added to the Pro Purse

A line will be drawn on the track on the second straight, first Elite Male to cross the line wins for that Moto/Semi/Main.

How it works:

- ⇒ In Moto 1 prize money of \$50 is awarded.
If there are more than 1 gate for Moto 1, prize money is split between the number of gates. Prize money is awarded to the first Elite Male rider to cross the line drawn on the second straight of the track.
- ⇒ In Moto 2 prize money of \$100 is awarded.
If there are more than 1 gate for Moto 2, prize money is split between the number of gates. Prize money is awarded to the first Elite Male rider to cross the line drawn on the second straight of the track.
- ⇒ In Moto 3 prize money of \$200 is awarded.
If there are more than 1 gate for Moto 3, prize money is split between the number of gates. Prize money is awarded to the first Elite Male rider to cross the line drawn on the second straight of the track.
- ⇒ In Semi Events prize money of \$400 is awarded.
Prize money is split between 2 gates.
Prize money is awarded to the first Elite Male rider to cross the line drawn on the second straight of the track.
- ⇒ In Main Event **WITH** a Semi Event prize money of \$800 is awarded.
Prize money is awarded to the first Elite Male rider to cross the line drawn on the second straight of the track.
- ⇒ In Main Event **WITHOUT** a Semi Event prize money of \$400 is awarded.
Prize money is awarded to the first Elite Male rider to cross the line drawn on the second straight of the track.

If the winner of the Moto/Semi/Main is disqualified, relegated or has ANY call made on them for any infractions anywhere on the track during the Moto/Semi/Main, either before or after the Dash for Cash winning line, that rider will forfeit any winnings for Dash for Cash and 2nd place rider will receive their winnings in that round.

EXAMPLES:

If there are Semi Events - Moto 1, Moto 2 & Moto 3 prize money is split 3-ways (3 gates)

If there are NO Semi Events and only a Main Event – Moto 1, Moto 2 & Moto 3 prize money is split 2-ways (2 gates)

If there are NO Semi events and NO Main Event – Moto 1, Moto 2 & Moto 3 prize money is awarded to the winner of each moto. (1 gate)

There will be 3 officials scheduled to score the Dash for Cash events at the line drawn.

Dash for Cash is NOT part of any Alberta BMX format for Pro Payouts and is independent to Okotoks BMX Club only.
